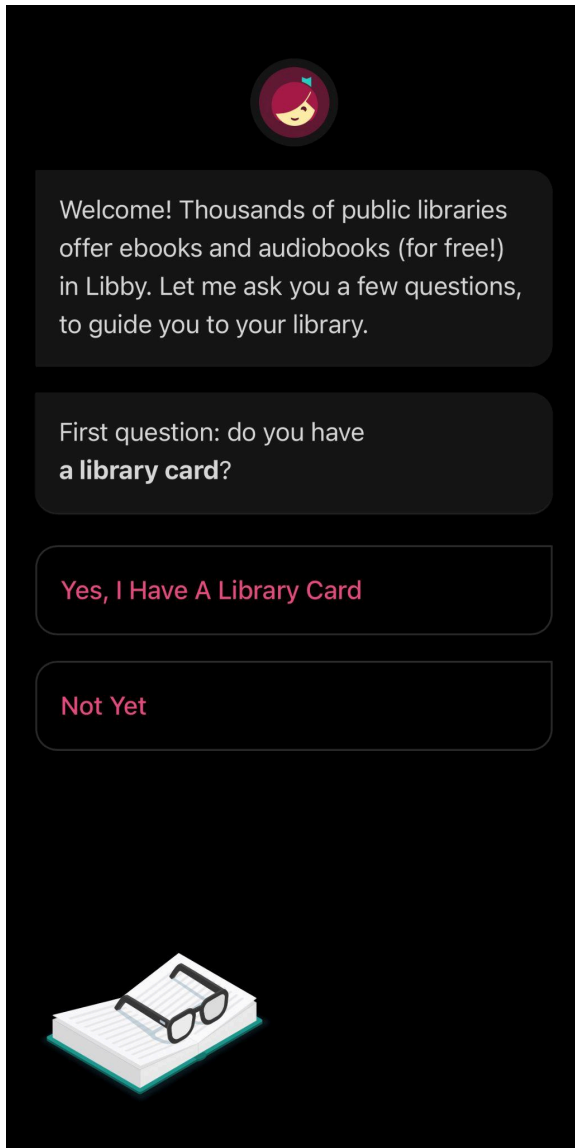

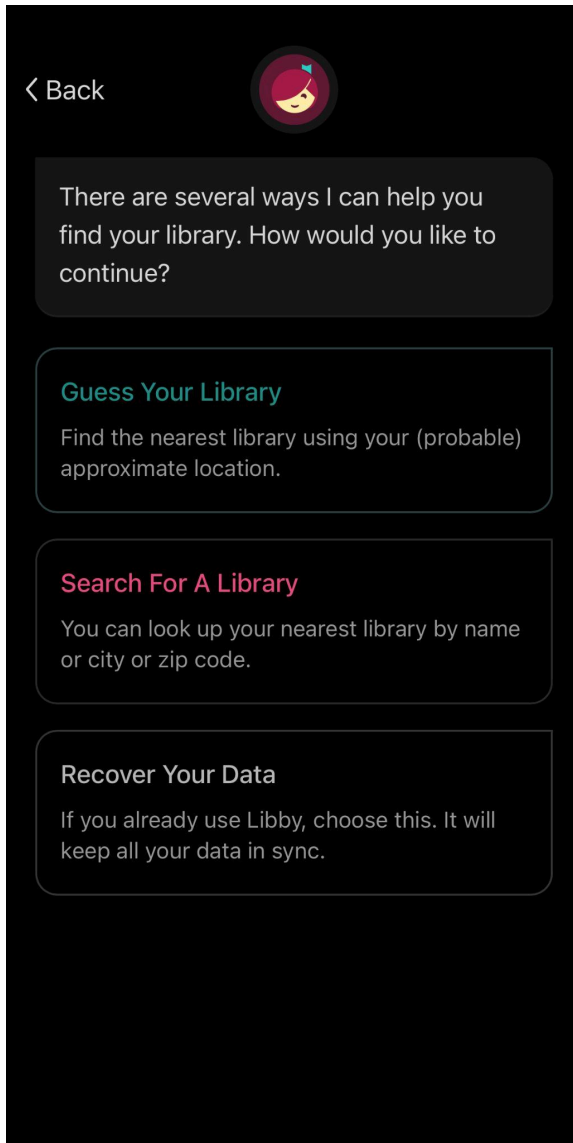
When you open your app for the first time, you will see a

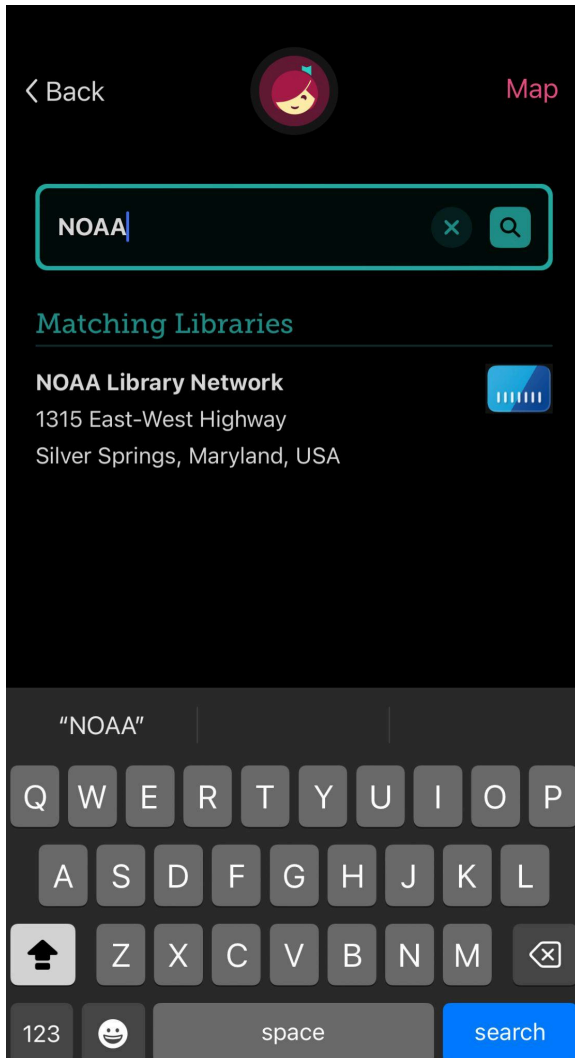
The next screen asks about your library.

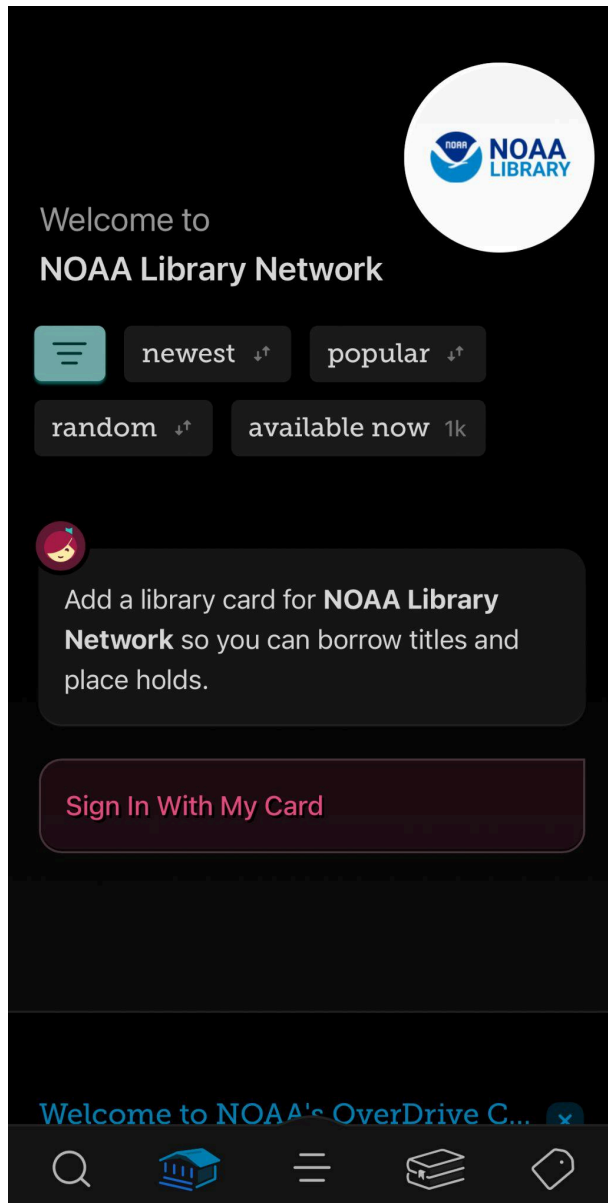
The next screen opens a search box.

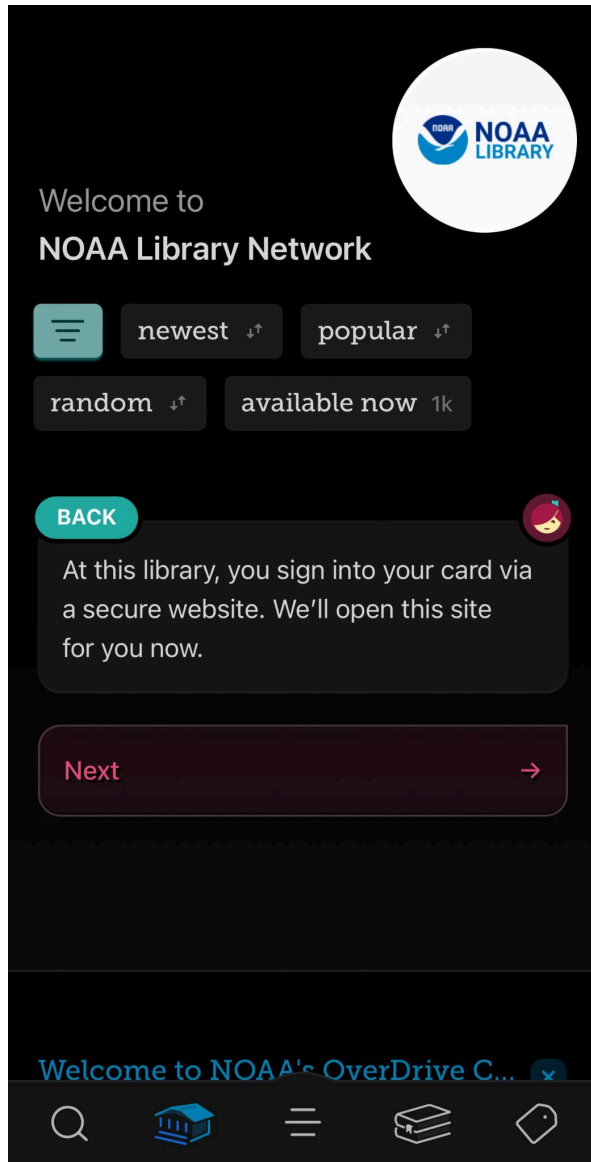
The NOAA Libraries icon should appear on the screen.

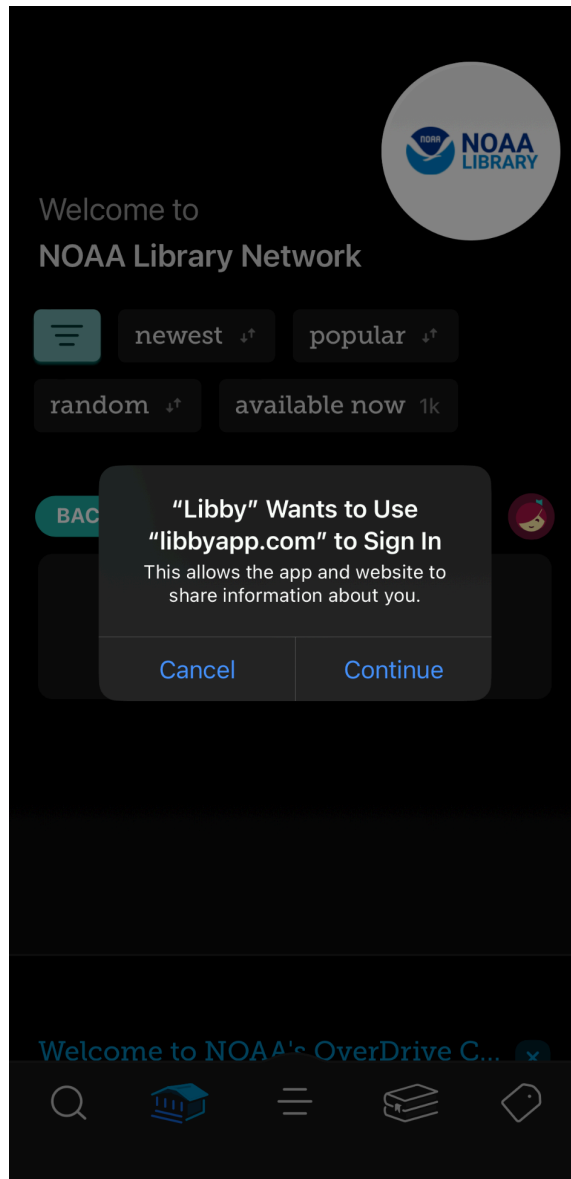

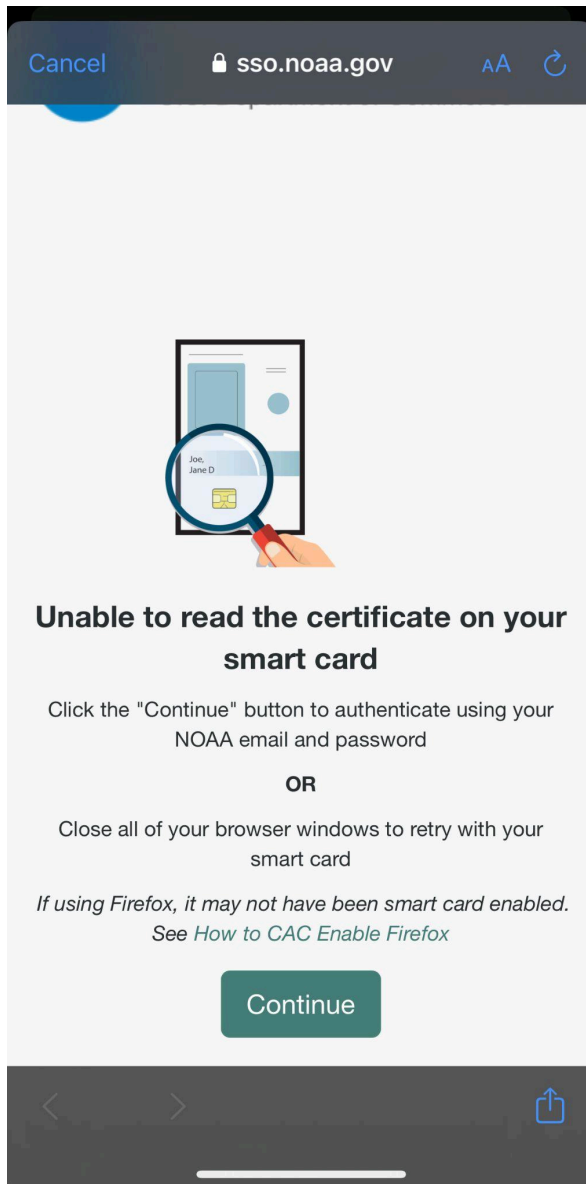


You may see this message, “Unable to read the certificate on your smart card.”

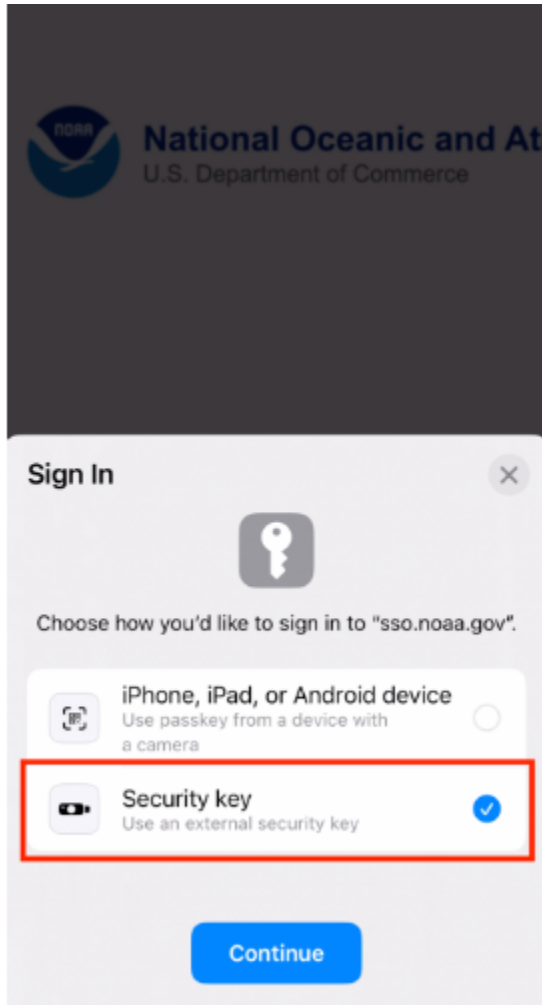

You will get a pop-up asking you to choose how you'd like to sign in to "sso.noaa.gov" if you have Multi-Factor Authentication set up for your noaa.gov account.

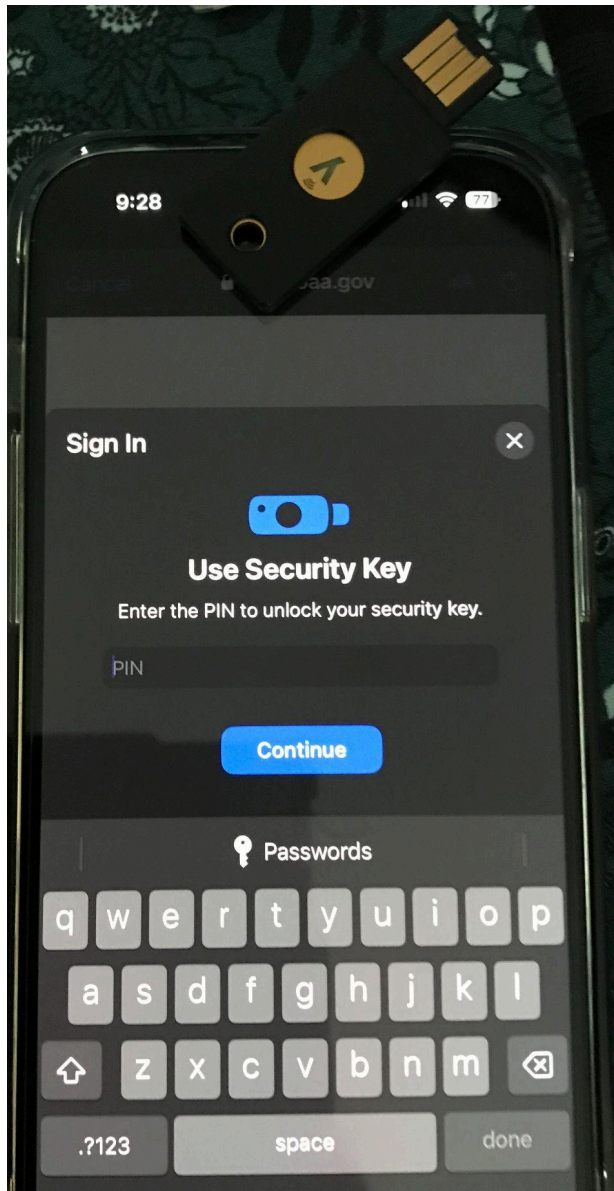
Select to use a security key (Yubikey option)

If you don't have a Yubikey set up, you may have the option to use the authenticator app

If you haven't set up MFA with your NOAA account you will need to do so. Follow instructions [here](#) to set up your Yubikey and contact your local help desk for assistance if needed.

To use the Yubikey, place the Yubikey near the top of your device. (Device must be NFC enabled)

A pop up will appear asking you to enter the PIN you set up for your Yubikey.

Enter your PIN number

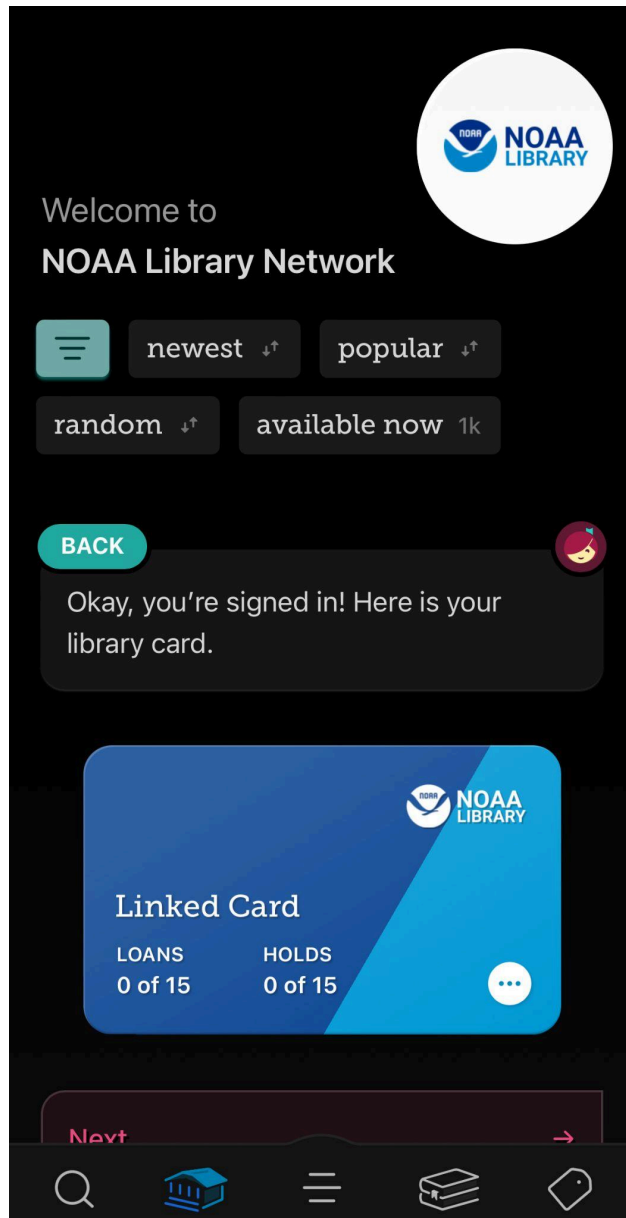

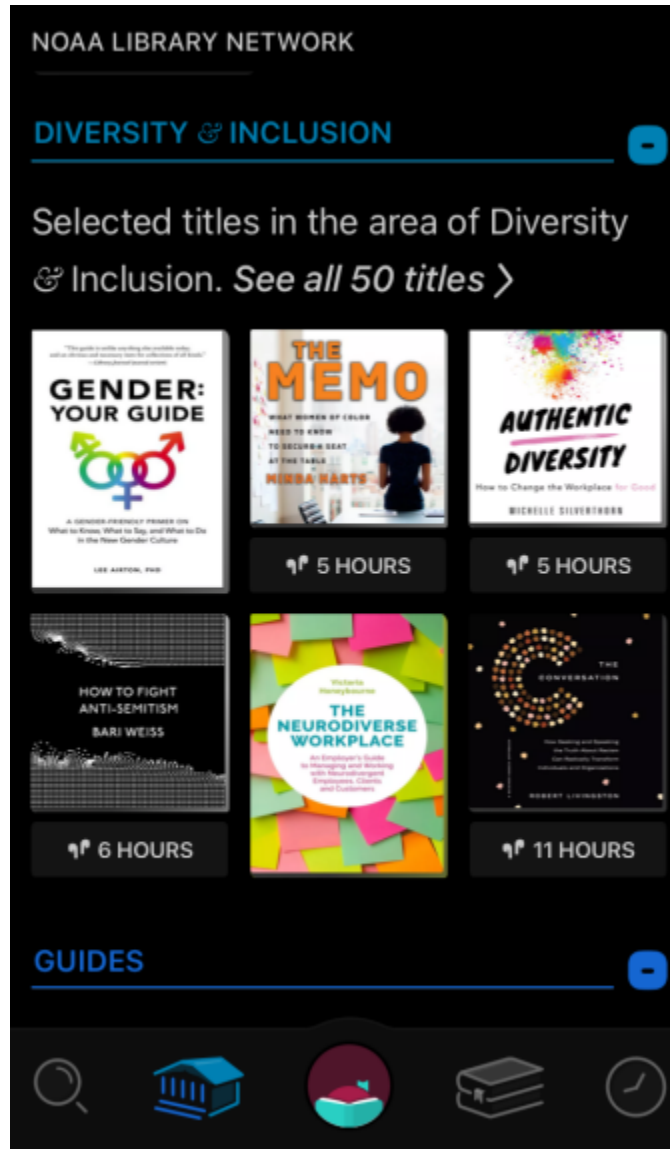
You are now signed in!

Titles are automatically returned at the end of the lending period. No late fees!

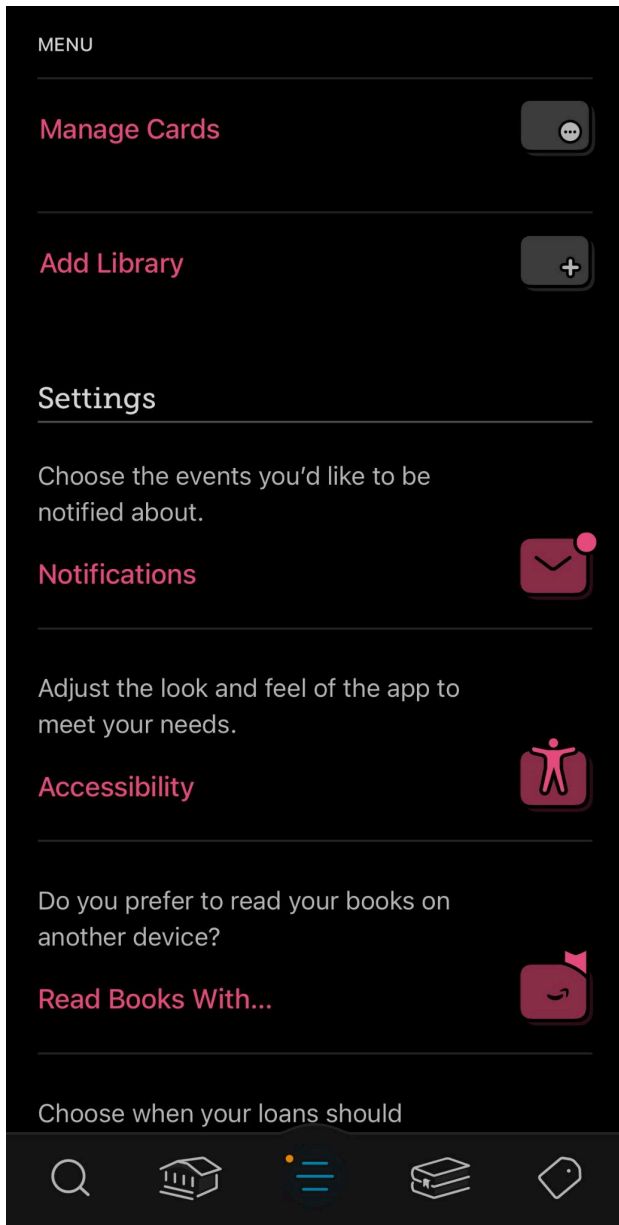
Check out up to **15 titles** at a time.

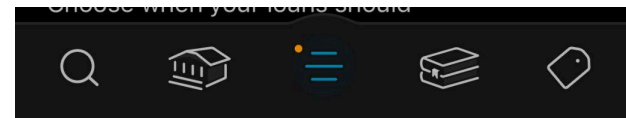

If you already have and use Libby, you can add your NOAA Account to your Library

In the Libby app select the center three vertical lines.



Scroll down past your current library cards and select **Add Library**
