Pablo - As we just discussed by phone, here is a draft transmission letter for the proposed RPA that follows the lines of what Barry and David agreed to on Friday. If you could please review with David, and let us know whether we have characterized this according to your understanding of the status of our discussions and path forward, that would be helpful. I am also attaching the highlight strikeout version of the summer temperature pilot program language. The cover letter states that you have agreed to implement this in 2017, while other components of the proposed language are still under discussion.

If you can review this and call me if it needs more discussions, and/or clarify by email what Reclamation's response will be, that would be helpful.
