Subject: Re: Oroville and ROC on LTO Core Team Meeting

All,

As discussed during this afternoon's ROC on LTO core team meeting, description of the SWP's Oroville Field Division can be found on pages 2-78 through 2-97 in the 2008 CVP/SWP operations BA (https://www.usbr.gov/mp/cvo/OCAP/sep08_docs/OCAP_BA_002_Aug08.pdf).

Reasons to include Oroville Reservoir and operations in the ROC on LTO BA:

1. The implementing regulations for the ESA state that "Each Federal agency shall review its actions at the earliest possible time to determine whether any action may affect listed species or critical habitat" [50 CFR 402.14(a), <http://www.nmfs.noaa.gov/pr/pdfs/laws/sec7regs.pdf>]. The section 7 consultation between FERC and NMFS may have addressed all of DWR's SWP operations of Oroville Dam. However, unless Reclamation designated FERC as the lead Federal action agency for the section 7 consultation, Reclamation has an independent responsibility to comply with ESA section 7(a)(2) on behalf of DWR (through the COA). That's what happened in the 2008 BA. In the 2009 BiOp, NMFS deferred the operations of Oroville to the FERC consultation (see section 1.5.3 on page 35 of NMFS' 2009 BiOp at http://www.westcoast.fisheries.noaa.gov/publications/Central_Valley/Water%20Operations/Operations,%20Criteria%20and%20Plan/nmfs biological and conference opinion on the long-term operations of the cvp and swp.pdf).
2. The FERC action area does not include the entire Feather River, does not include SWP water contractors, and does not consider effects of Oroville ops in the Sacramento River to and through the Delta.
