The genesis of the request is a species list that Reclamation shared with the ROC on LTO core team. I suggested that rather than a high level species list (e.g., for NMFS, that would be WR, SR, steelhead, GS, CCC steelhead, and SR killer whales), the species list should be broken down by division, so for example, for the American River division, we should include an analysis for effects on WR (Phyliss et al. is documentation of the need).

This was not intended to be a time-intensive exercise for Barb to get a Google doc out to everyone, nor a time-intensive exercise for everyone to take a look and contribute. Another example is if we think Reclamation needs to consult on or analyze effects of ROC on LTO on SR in the Stan, one document we can use as evidence or rationale is Sierra Frank's document/evaluation.
