Hello all -

We are looking to start brainstorming on the Reinitiation of Consultation (ROC) on the Coordinated Long-Term Operation (LTO) of the Central Valley Project (CVP) and State Water Project (SWP). This is a large effort and will require a great amount of coordination.

To start, we are looking to assemble geographically based interagency, interdisciplinary technical workgroups (ROC Bands) to identify and develop new ideas to meet the biological and operational functions of the CVP and SWP. Attached is a overview chart that describes this, as well as a draft Charter which further describes the purpose, objectives, process and timeline.

Also attached is a draft agenda. Initially we would like to start with a 2-day workshop identifying functions (how/why) and brainstorming solutions. For those of you who have participated in our previous Clear Creek, American River, or Trinity River versions, we have shortened the process. We're thinking the workshop would take place in Redding or Red Bluff, CA, and hopefully include a field tour.
