Quick update: We found out yesterday via the Commissioner that now we need BOs for the Long-term Re-Operation (process formerly known as Track 3) by August 2018.

Secondly, attached is a draft outline of our Near-Term Actions (formerly known as Track 1) Environmental Assessment. We are building this document incrementally over time, and hope to share each section with you as we get a draft together.

Right now, we have attached a description of the existing requirement (i.e. RPA), as well as new science related to that topic or action. Can you please help us by having your staff review this document and pull together any additional studies, articles, reports that we may be missing? Please help us by adding to the list of studies and information.
