Barb --

I don't recall any "upfront" listing of costs in the BA, though it may be hidden somewhere in an appendix or in the EIS.

I think it would be most efficient to simply contact Marcus Yee at DWR and ask him where they have documented what the structure is expected to cost. Note, though, that the proposal in the BA was for a gate similar to what was proposed in the SDIP, mostly as a placeholder. We are on record numerous times, including in comments to the draft BAs, as not being supportive of this design and advocating for study of a different design. So therefore there could be some notable uncertainty to the number that is used, if it is "specific" to the previous design.
