Subject: Draft Shasta RPA amendment workshop #4

Maria,

The Reclamation and NMFS hold on December 14 for workshop #4 is fast approaching. As discussed, if we stick with the date and time, we will need to send a "save-the-date" e-mail out to everyone very quickly.

A draft agenda (no durations or time for Q&A determined yet) could include:

- A presentation by me (and maybe Jeff) on more details associated with the draft Shasta amendment, with a comparison to the 2011 amendment so folks know what we're adding, deleting, or modifying;
- A presentation by Evan on the draft science and monitoring work plan; and
- A presentation (by Jeff or Randi?) on the pilot/operational study this year.

I just talked to Jeff R, who talked to Federico about the timing of workshop #4, and they are both in favor of postponing until January. Jeff indicated that Reclamation's modeling work (analyze system-wide effects of the draft Shasta amendment) is ready to be presented at a workshop, but that's without the benefit of both agencies discussing and syncing up messaging.

Seems like a call between Federico and you is needed in short order to decide on workshop #4 on December 14 or in January.
