

Shasta RPA Draft Proposed Amendment

Purpose:

This meeting represents the fourth of four stakeholder meetings to discuss the draft proposed amendment (issued January 19, 2017) to the Reasonable and Prudent Alternative of the 2009 NMFS Biological Opinion for the long-term operation of the Central Valley and State Water Projects related to Shasta Reservoir operations. This meeting will focus on several topics; (1) review of temperature operations for the 2017 Sacramento River temperature management season, (2) system-wide analyses of the draft proposed amendment, (3) next steps in the amendment process, and (4) draft science plan.

The meeting is intended to provide a forum for updating stakeholders and interested parties on the progress of each of the items above. The U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and NOAA's National Marine Fisheries Service will provide an overview of the status of these efforts, and will be interested in learning more about thoughts, concepts, and ideas from stakeholders on continued implementation of these activities.
