Was a permanent screen ever developed?

Only thing I found on sacdata was 2014 biop: Screen Facility Short-term Protection Project at the site of the M&T Chico Ranch/Llano Seco Rancho Pumping Plant.

EnvB section on Diversions:

In addition, the 2009 RPA included the requirement to identify and implement any required projects to assure the M&T Ranch water diversion is adequately screened to protect winter-run Chinook salmon, spring-run Chinook salmon, and steelhead. **A short-term screen is currently functioning at the site and a permanent screening option is under development.**
