SWRCB--May need permanent change to WRO-90-5

Late season temperatures very important, so we don't want to overshoot early. EPA (2003) is important, but we need to make sure the resource can be spread out to apply throughout the season.

Reclamation has been plotting other cold water volumes in addition to 49 degrees.

Coordinating temperature and modeling work plan

-- Does Reclamation know what management questions need to be asked/addressed? Reclamation needs to think about it.

Lessons learned--Reclamation may change some, reorganize

Consider phasing: Absolutely necessary over the next 3 months, what we can postpone and wait.

2 processes:

1. Generating forecasts
2. Sacramento River temperature management planning
