Hi all,

I realized we are bit late to this party so bear with us as we catch-up – I’ve asked a few folks here to review the presentation and have a few comments we’d like to offer for your consideration – please let me know if something doesn’t make sense or you think we should discuss. Thanks Cindy

Slides 12-18 – It is unclear that some of these facilities/activities/responsibilities are shared between the CVP and SWP, especially in light of Slide 18, which lists SWP facilities separately.

Slides 14 and 21 – Slide 14 lists the Yolo Bypass BiOp Projects and Slide 21 states that all CVP and SWP service areas (which were described in Slides 12-18) will be within the Project Scope. But we are already seeking separate consultations for Yolo Bypass BiOp Projects (e.g., FWAFP) that are underway and expect to seek separate consultations for future Bypass BiOp Projects (e.g., Salmonid Fish Passage and Habitat Restoration Project aka the “Inundation Notch Project”). Is the current approach changing or are these slides incorrect?

Slide 23 – What “habitat” is included in the type of actions within the Project Scope? See above comments regarding Slides 14 and 21.

Slide 24 – “Fresh Look Concept” – “Look at something completely different” and “Look at something completely differently” have two very distinct meanings. I think we want to say “Look at something completely differently.”

Other comment that I don’t feel warrants a change in the presentation at this point, but I want to flag for discussion when more DWR staff are engaged in this process

Slide 9 – There is a lot of meat here without a lot of clarity regarding specific content. We should ask for more information about what would be said with respect to each bullet point to make sure we are comfortable with the message.
