Hi Garwin - the comment below was received as part of the SJRRP implementation discussions, which seems to imply that there has been further discussion of Friant being included in LTO? Is that true?

- South Valley Water Authority is concerned over the connection between implementation of the SJRRP and statements made in the reconsulation process and elsewhere related to flows from Friant Dam for delta outflow and Refuge supply. As part of this process, it will be important for Reclamation to establish parameters and practices to ensure that re-diversions of restoration flows at and below Mendota Pool or Sack Dam are accounted for only as Recapture Flows for the benefit of the Friant Division under the Water Management Goal of the Settlement
